

Dog Play Areas Guidelines

Play areas (i.e. education center, upper play yard, other outside play yards) used by various dogs throughout the day have the following guidelines for toys and water bowls. This is in order to reduce risk of disease spread.

Toys & Water Bowls:

- There should be NO TOYS or communal water bowl left out.
- Fresh, clean toys must be put in the area bin. Do NOT scatter about the play area.
- A fresh, clean water bowl may be provided for the dog/play session.
- EVERY TIME you and your dog are done playing, bring in the used toys and used water bowl to be washed in the dog kitchen.
- Please walk dogs for one loop before and after using the play yards.

The Upper Play Yard is the primary location for the dog socialization (adoptable meet up and play date) program. Therefore, if a single dog and volunteer or staff person is using the yard, they may be asked to move to another play yard or end the play session.
