

Volunteer Department

- Total number of volunteer hours: 79,942
- Time Equivalent to 38 full-time paid staff members!

Intake Department

- Total Dog Intakes- 2,377
- Total Cat Intakes-3,619
- Over 1500 animals came in on the Love Train!
- Return to Owners:
 - o Dogs- 55.8%
 - o Cats-21%
 - (highest ever for cats)
- 243 animals were rehomed via our Private Adoptions Page- keeping them out of the shelter!



- 1,946 volunteer hours in 2021
- Kitten Love Trains in 2022
 - Look for 2 new assignments in VIC. Passenger assignment and Arrival Assistant



Humane Education

- Because of our volunteers we were able to reach over
 4,500 people
 - o 273 campers
 - o 463 rescue readers
 - o 359 party participants
 - o And many more!
- Humane Ed volunteers put in **565 hours** in 2021. That's amazing!





Dog Behavior

- Able to resume volunteer programs that were "on hold" since the start of the pandemic
 - Weekly Dog Play Groups using improved protocols from Shelter Playgroup Alliance
 - Sunday off-site group hikes
- New Head Start volunteers trained, enabling us to fully "staff" our Head Start teams again.
- 11, 357 hours volunteers spent working with our dogs!
- New volunteer assignment added: Decompression Time!
 - Great opportunity to get dogs some relaxing time out of kennel
- Enrichment Yard being planned for 2022!
 - o Plan to modify one play yard to be an "enrichment garden" offering dogs more opportunities for sensory, physical, and mental enrichment.



Cat Behavior

- We saw more cats come through our doors than we've seen in the last 15 years!
 - o Nearly 4000 cats came through intake
 - o 422 of those were transfers from local shelters
 - 4,800 hours of volunteer cat care hours
- Looking into 2022...we are working on a volunteerbased enrichment and kitten socialization program.
- Revisit the Headstart program, allowing more assignment for in-depth behavior treatment.





Foster Program

- Resumed in person foster orientations
- Welcomed over **100 new foster** volunteers to the program.
- Added training materials and continuing education courses for foster volunteers
- Streamlined our processes for fosters to ensure that everyone was receiving appropriate foster request emails and to help save more lives.
- 2,076 animals fostered by volunteers in 2021
- 38,547 volunteer hours spent caring for foster animals

Adoptions

- **5,352** adoptions in 2021, this is **367** MORE than in 2020!
- 134 dogs left on Pajama Parties, 95 were adopted!
- We updated and streamline the adoption materials sent home (from around 15 to 4-5) which now includes a nice booklet containing the information they will need
- **96.5%** save rate







Tiny Lions

- 682 adoptions in 2021 (remember, we were closed through April).
- 11,240 visitors to the café through programming, events, and café visits
- 6,468 volunteer hours
- 152 Tiny Lions Volunteers- adult program
- 16 JV Tiny Lions Volunteers
- Return of programming such as trivia night (with virtual option) and yoga



Community Cats

- 1,439 volunteer hours spent trapping and feeding
- 1,577 sterilizations completed

Bountiful Bowls

- 43,179 pounds of food distributed to those in need
- 895 volunteer hours spent helping with this program

Clinic

- Added to our volunteer surgery support team by offering a surgery support training in November
- 1,396 volunteer hours provided wrapping surgical packs and helping with our Low Cost Vaccination clinics
- 8,485 sterlizations performed
