

Enucleation Surgical Estimate

A \$100 deposit is required at time of scheduling Special Instructions/Comments:

The patient will typically be hospitalized overnight (additional \$35 overnight hospitalization fee) after the procedure and will go home the following morning with antibiotics and pain medication. At discharge, a pressure wrap may be sutured over the surgical site to minimize swelling. This will need to be removed by a veterinarian 2-3 days post-surgery. The patient may need to go home with an Elizabethan collar to prevent them from scratching or pawing at their face while it heals (additional \$10 charge if needed).

The sutures will need to be removed 10-14 days post-surgery. This is often accomplished without sedation. If sedation is needed, there may be additional charges.
