




Dr. Brian Hare: Scientist, **Author, Primatologist &** Dog Guy.

Dr. Hare has spent his life tracking down clues to explain the remarkable bond between

humans and canines. He is a core member of the Center of Cognitive Neuroscience and a Professor in Evolutionary Anthropology, Psychology and Neuroscience at Duke University. Dr. Hare researches the evolution of cognition in both primates and domestic dogs, and has published over 100 scientific papers as well as New York Times Bestseller *The Genius of Dogs.* He is the co-founder of Dognition and host of National Geographic's *Is* Your Dog a Genius?, implementing scientific tests to reveal a dog's cognitive skills and insight into how to improve their bond with their humans.
