


Our Mission

To encourage loving, responsible care of all animals in our community, to prevent suffering, and to save as many lives as possible.



A Little History...

- Founded in 1896
- New shelter completed in 2009
- 501(c)(3) charitable organization
 - A private, independent nonprofit agency



HSHV is an Open Admission Shelter

What Does This Mean?

We accept animals even when shelter is full.

We accept animals who are sick or injured.

We fit the definition of “no kill” set by Maddie’s Fund.

We rarely use this term due to confusion.

Euthanasia does happen as a humane course of action.

No “time limit” for adoptions.

Our Save Rate

- HSHV Named Best Animal Shelter for the highest animal “save rate.”

A Little History...

- Opened in May of 2016
- Named after Cecil the Lion
- Do you know where the first known cat café in the world was?

Cat Flower Garden" (貓花園), opened in Taipei, Taiwan, in 1998

Cats are chosen by TLC Staff. Come from main shelter. Kitten coming up through Kitten Love Train (typically winter months)



We offer fun programming each month!



There is an admission fee. Open to all groups and ages

If a Cat Gets Loose

- Remain Calm
- Call for staff assistance immediately
- Avoid chasing the cat
- Watch to see where/he she goes
- Keep the area safe (alert cars, etc.)

Things to Know

What to Wear

- Volunteer shirt (optional)
- Name tag
- Close toed shoes

Cell Phones

- Should not be out
- Sign out if you need to make a call

Other Policies

- Smoke-free facility
- Weapons/Alcohol-free facility
- Park closest to furniture store when possible



Volunteering around Animals


- Exposure to Germs/Diseases.
 - Zoonotic-animal to human (i.e. Ringworm).
 - Other diseases animal-animal (i.e. URI's).
- Humans are the largest carriers of germs.
 - Always sanitize hands.
- After Volunteering, we recommend...
 - Clothing-
 - wash in hot water/color-safe bleach. Dry in the dryer on highest setting.
 - Shoes-
 - wipe down and/or have a separate pair just for volunteering.

Overview of the Cafe!




Kitchen

- Main Location for VIC sign-in
 - Use phone number (minus area code)
- Nametags are on the counter
 - Permanent nametags at Tail 2 (10 hours)



Back Room

- Where you will find shelter cleaning assignments
- Laundry goes here
- Where feeding and cleaning supplies are located




Program Room

- Can be rented for parties/events
