Canine Dental Procedure Estimate (UNDER 50 pounds)

Pre-Anesthetic Blood Work (required for pets 7 or older, but recommended for all) – must be done in advance and within 3 months prior to the dental procedure – Cost NOT included in this estimate. This estimate is only valid for 6 months after it is presented. If your pet has not received the discussed procedure within this timeframe, another consultation is required.

*Based on \$330 per hour (\$5.50/minute) of oral surgery time (includes extraction, suturing and post-extraction x-ray). Although extractions may not be anticipated at the time of oral exam, there is always a possibility that they will be needed. We do our best to make you aware if tooth extractions will be needed. However, once dental tartar is cleaned away and x-rays are taken, problems that were not obviously visible before have the potential to be present.

Since your pet will be under anesthesia, we won't be able to contact you before extractions are performed. Please know that we only remove teeth when absolutely necessary for your pet's health and comfort.
